

Visa Preparation Guide

In order to process your visa request, the following documents must be provided. Please review the list carefully, and contact us with any questions.

Original JW202 Form

This form is also called the “Visa Application for Study in China.” Be sure to sign and date the **Signature of Applicant** section (bottom right).

Original Chinese University Admission Notice

Some schools may require your signature. If so, please make sure it is signed.

Photocopy of the JW202 Form & Chinese University Admission Notice

The photocopy does not need to be in color; black & white is fine. The Embassy will keep the original JW202 Form, and return the original Chinese University Admission Notice. You will receive it back in your package along with your passport and completed visa.

V2013 Visa Application Form of the People's Republic of China

This form is four pages. The Embassy requires all fields on this form to be completed and signed. Handwritten application forms are not accepted. All the blanks must be filled out properly. Please also attach a 2” X 2” passport style photo to the application form. You can staple it, tape it, or glue it onto the form. The photo must be professionally taken and printed. Low quality photos on paper are not accepted.

Original Valid US Passport

The visa is a sticker that gets glued into your passport. Please make sure your passport has at least 12 month's validity, and a blank visa page within it. Visas cannot be pasted to the Amendment page.

Photocopy of Your Passport

Please also include a photocopy of the information page of your passport. This is the page with your name, picture, DOB, place of issue, information included.

Oasis Visa Online Registration and Receipt

After you registered your order online, you should get a receipt. Please include a copy of this receipt in the package.

For Non-us citizen students, original I-20 (or, original green card/notarized copy of the green card) is needed for the visa processing.
